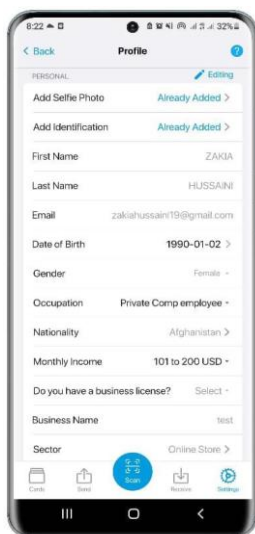

Here's a step-by-step guide for using the HesabPay Developer Portal:

Sign up and business account registration process:


Anyone with an approved business account can use the developer portal.

- Download the HesabPay App.
- After entering your phone number and OTP, you'll be redirected to the profile page.
- Enter Profile Information and your Business Information.
- In the profile section, find the option **"Do you have a business license?"**.
- Select **"Yes"** and enter all the details of your business. Then, click on the submit button.
- After submitting your business information, our team will review and verify the details provided.
- Once your business account is approved successfully, you can use and login to the Developer portal.




Access the Developer Portal:

- After your business account is approved, go to your web browser and visit the following URL: <https://developers.hesab.com/login>.
- Use the same credentials you used to create your HesabPay business account to log in to the Developer Portal.



- After logging in, you will be redirected to the Developer Portal home page
- On the home page, navigate to the “**Developer**” section. Then, click on the “**generate key**” button. This API key is essential for integrating HesabPay with your website or application.

Your API Key:
Your API key serves as a unique identifier for integrating with HesabPay. It's essential for creating secure payment sessions. Handle this key with utmost care to prevent unauthorized access.

Integrate with HesabPay:

- Once you have obtained the API key, utilize it to integrate HesabPay's payment functionality into your platform.
- Incorporate the necessary code into your website or application to enable users to make payments through HesabPay.

Send Transaction Details via API:


- When a user initiates a transaction on your platform, ensure that you automatically send a list of items and their corresponding prices to HesabPay via the API.
- For example, if a user adds items to their cart on your e-commerce platform, automatically send the names of the items and their individual prices to HesabPay.

Redirect to the payment page:

- Redirect the paying user to the HesabPay payment page, where they can view the transaction details, including the purchased items and the total amount to be paid. The payment page will offer the following options: pay using HesabPay, Pay as Guest and Distributing Payments to Multiple Vendors

- **HesabPay account**

The paying user will log in to their HesabPay account and verify their PIN. Once authenticated, the transaction will be automatically processed and paid.

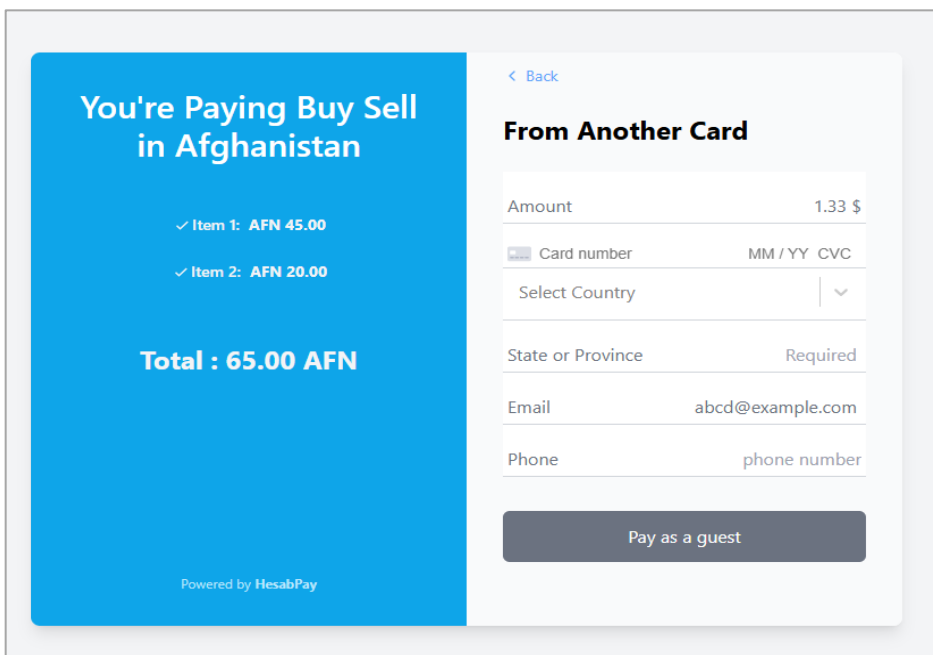
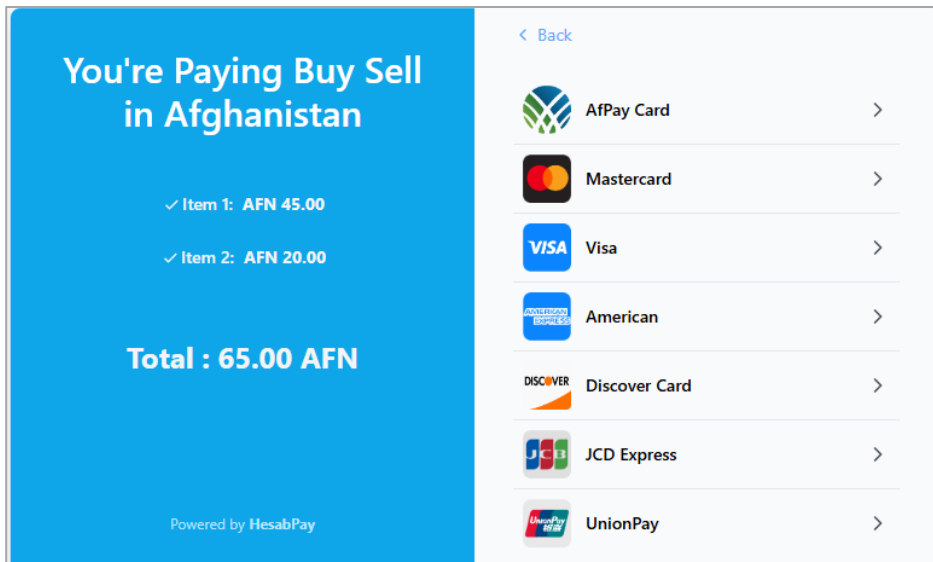

If the user selects "Pay as Guest," they will be presented with various payment options to complete their transaction.




- [Distributing Payments to Multiple Vendors](#)

Using this API, merchants can seamlessly transfer the respective amounts to each vendor's account after a successful payment session

Step 1: Obtaining an API Key

To begin integrating HesabPay into your application, the first step is to obtain an API key. This key is essential as it authenticates and authorizes your application to interact with HesabPay's services. Here's how you can get your API key:

Access API Key Management: Navigate to the Developer section in the dashboard and then click on the API keys tab.

Generate API Key: Follow the instructions to generate a new API key. Remember, this key should be kept confidential and not exposed to the public.

Step 2: Creating a Payment Session

Once you have your API key, you can create a payment session. This involves sending a request to HesabPay's API endpoint with your API key and a list of items the user wishes to purchase.

Note: Make sure to append **API-KEY** in the Authorization header before your API key.
